Student centered learning experiences, with the student as the worker and teacher as coach, will be designed to create actively engaged learners focused around an essential question or problem to be solved



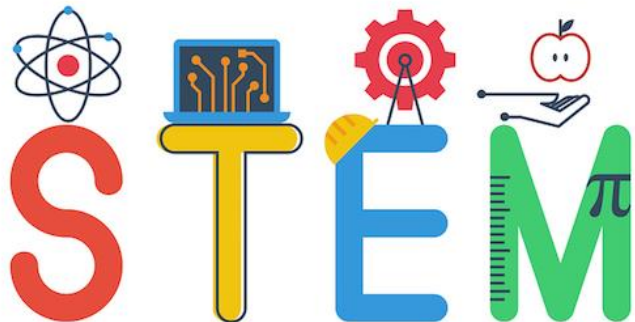

- We will continue our partnership with the University of Hawaii, Maui Campus (UHMC) to provide our students with access to Early Admit dual-credit college courses



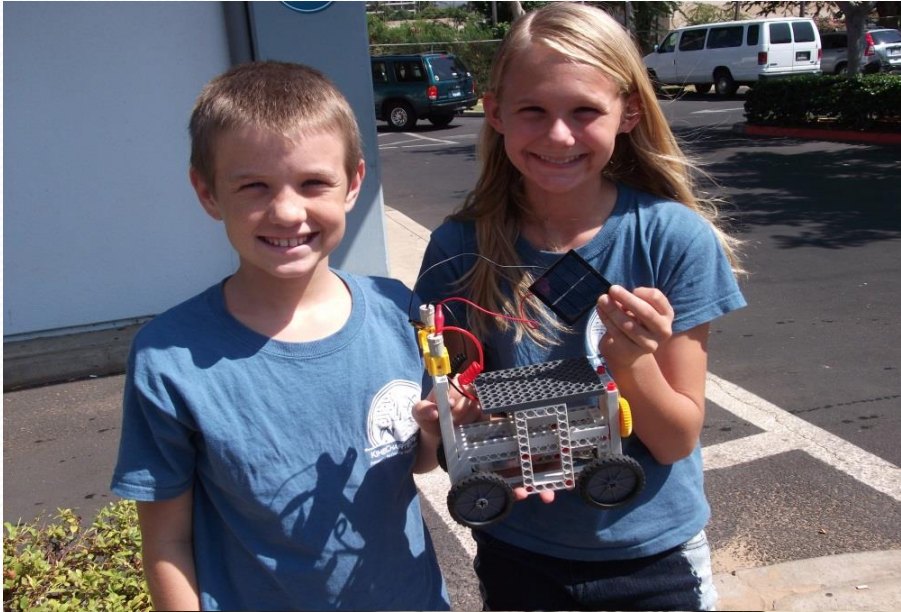
