Kihei Charter School students deserve to have their education fully funded by the state of Hawaii with full access to resources that will allow students to reach their full potential.

Unfortunately this is not the case, so KCS is turning to our 'Ohana in hopes of raising additional funding to provide much needed educational resources.

As a state entity, public charter schools may not directly solicit funds.
However, we are fortunate to have South Maui Learning Ohana (SMLO) as our partner in education. SMLO is a non-profit organization and has the ability to accept gifts and offer receipts that allow tax deductibility. Due to our partnership, the school receives 100% of the gift and funds are allocated to the project of the donor's choice.

The Leadership Team has developed a list of key items that will benefit students and immediately enhance the KCS Experience.

## **Priority Educational Resources:**

Elementary School – garden tools, composter and a portable shed to be used at the school garden. \$2000

Middle School – 25 heavy duty laptops on a mobile cart to be used in the middle school to increase student access to technology. \$13000

High School – 15 Ipads/tablets for the Spanish language department to be used to acquire higher-level conversation skills. \$5000

High School — Athletic team uniforms and equipment for cross country, paddling and track teams. \$4500
